Being a parent: A lot of fun – a lot of hard work!

In their first years, children learn more and faster than in any other time of their lives.

Have an impact on your child's future by playing and learning together with him.

HIPPY – Fit to Start School

- HIPPY is a programme for playing and learning developed for families with children over three years of age.
- HIPPY will show you how you can promote your child's development by playing with her in your home.
- HIPPY offers your child the best possible preparation for school.
- Migrant children may also improve their German language skills together with their parents.

Home Visits

A HIPPY worker will regularly bring playing and learning materials to your home and explain how to play with these materials.

All home visitors are bilingual and can help you with translations.

If any questions arise from playing and learning together with your child, you can discuss them with the home visitor.

After the home visit ...

... you will play and learn with your child every day, for about 20 minutes. Playing together is fun and will prepare your child for learning in school later.

Group Meetings

There is a group meeting every two weeks.

Experts will provide you with information on topics such as school, health care, nutrition and education issues.

The group meetings will also give you an opportunity to talk with others, learn from each other and give each other support.

You will make new contacts and find out about other resources and services offered in your area.
